Background

The School, within guidelines established by the Minister of Education, and requirements of The Education Act, 1995, determines the school year and hours of operation.

Procedures

- 1. School Year
 - 1.1. The school director establishes a recommended school calendar for presentation to the Board. The school calendar must meet all requirements set out by the Ministry of Education.
 - 1.2. The approved calendar is to be published for the information of parents and pupils on the school website, and in school newsletters.

2. School Day

- 2.1. The principal, in consultation with the school director, is to determine the starting time, breaks and recesses, lunch hour, and dismissal of the school.
- 2.2. Parental and transportation concerns are to be considered.
- 2.3. Normally, kindergarten students are to attend the minimum of an equivalent of ninety school days.
- 3. School Opening and Closing
 - 3.1. The principal, in consultation with the school director, may dismiss school at any time before the usual dismissal time where the health, safety, or well-being of students or staff is threatened. Refer to Administrative Procedure 553 Closure, Severe Weather, and Student Transportation.
